


CLIMATE STATISTICS

Consists of tabulated information for more than 1000 sites. The tables prepared for each site provide averages and other statistics for a number of elements including: Maximum, minimum and ground surface temperatures, rainfall and other daily elements including sunshine and evaporation where available. Also temperature, humidity, wind and cloud (nominally) at 9am and 3 pm.

How to locate CLIMATE STATISTICS

(1) Go to the home page - www.bom.gov.au

Locate the satellite image map of Australia:-



From the above map - select and click on any state or territory (for example, Victoria)

(2) Under the sub heading – **Climate Information**

Locate and select the link “**Victoria Climate Averages**”

(3) Under the page heading – **Climate statistics for Australian sites**

Locate the site that you require the data for and select the corresponding ‘**MONTHLY STATISTICS**’ link.

Climate averages for this site should appear in a format similar to the table below.
