Fyshwick Lagoons Remedial Works 2013-14

ACTEW Water has been undertaking remediation works to improve the long-term sustainability of the effluent lagoons located at the Fyshwick Sewage Treatment Plant. The initial phase of this project concluded in October 2013.

Due to the site's recent exposure to high winds resulting in embankment erosion additional works are essential to install further erosion protection measures. These construction works will involve movement of heavy machinery and earthmoving equipment throughout the entire site. During this period we will also be establishing vegetation for erosion control on the embankments of the effluent lagoons located at the northern end of the treatment works.

ACTEW Water asks that the community using nearby recreation areas be aware of the increased traffic movements and are reminded that there is no public access to the Fyshwick Sewage Treatment Plant or lagoons. Construction is expected to be completed in Autumn 2014.
