I live near Liverpool in Western Sydney. I am fighting to save a regionally significant piece of woodland habitat from being destroyed for an industrial development.

A recent ecological constraints report for the developer found nine threatened species, four locally significant species, two nationally significant migratory species and a total of 63 native species. Two Birds Australia surveys bring the tally to well over 100, and we know that all the species aren't counted yet! All this a couple of kilometres from the CBD of a major city!

I am putting together a beautiful booklet with a photo of every species. I would send it to ministers and councillors and such persons as may be able to assist the cause.
